PTA president Christina Yazbek called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. Quorum was met. 11 members logged on. Toni-Lynn Riccardi (1st V. P.) and Diana Armandi (Treasurer) were present). Mrs. Kimball (Principal). Johana Tedesco (Secretary) and Christina Minetto (2nd V.P.) were absent.

- III. President's Report (Christina Yazbek)
 - 3. Chair/Fundraising & Event Report
 - <u>Audit Committee</u> Composed of at least three non-check signers. Need to review the books for the year. Toni Riccardi and Lisa Quenzer volunteered. Christina asked for additional volunteers and Diana Armandi reported that she had previously collected the names of approximately 10 people willing to volunteer. Diana will arrange with the volunteers to conduct the audit and report the members to Christina.

- Interim Summer Budget Needed to bridge the gap between the end of the current fiscal year (June 30th) and the proposed 2024-2025 being approved at the September meeting (September 30th). The proposed budget was \$100 for supplies, \$200 for training, \$480 for spirit apparel, \$450 for Staff Welcome Back Lunch, \$75 for Kindergarten Play Date, and \$2000 for the Welcome Back Social. No discussion took place. A motion to vote on the budget was made by Katie Poppe and seconded by Noelle Belmonte. A vote was held, 8 in favor, 0 against. The Interim Summer Budget was approved.
- <u>Volunteer Acknowledgments</u> Christina thanked the many people who helped out over the year including Mrs. Kimball, the office staff, and the teachers and other staff members who supported our efforts. Chairs, cochairs, and volunteers were thanked. Special recognition was given to the volunteers who are leaving Bosti: Diana Armandi, Kelly Bernius, Johnny & Mary Brush, Michelle Distelkamp, Audra Malone, and Dorothy Roventini.

2. Report of Standing Committees
